



## TelePacific Communications to Acquire Orange County Internet Xchange

### OCiX ACQUISITION MESSAGE POINTS

#### Transaction Overview

- TelePacific Communications and the shareholders of Orange County Internet Exchange (OCiX) have entered into a definitive agreement for TelePacific to acquire OCiX.
- Under the agreement, TelePacific will acquire all of OCiX's stock and control of a SAS 70 Type II certified data center located in Santa Ana, CA.
- The SAS 70 Type II certified data center is a technologically advanced and secure 10,000 square-foot facility, with significant expansion space available. It features multiple redundancy and backup systems and is carrier neutral.

#### Benefits

- The acquisition further enhances TelePacific's colocation and business continuity services by providing a state of the art SAS 70 Type II data center in Southern California.
- This will be TelePacific's second SAS 70 certified data center and will be a Southern California counterpart to its data center in Sacramento, which was acquired in November of last year through a transaction with 01 Communications.
- Coupled with TelePacific's existing Irvine colocation facility, the new data center will increase service capacity to TelePacific's SMB customers.
- This transaction continues TelePacific's track record of consolidating in-market CLECs and assets that will further leverage TelePacific's operating structure.
- TelePacific's customers will benefit from the addition of a SAS 70 Type II certified data and colocation service in Southern California, allowing TelePacific to provide additional services to customers and penetrate new vertical markets.
- OCiX customers will benefit from the opportunity to consolidate their voice and data services with one provider, and have access to TelePacific's enhanced business services to improve employee productivity—from wireless connectivity, redundancy solutions for both voice and data and high bandwidth Ethernet access services to customer portals that allow customers to pay their bills online, monitor their network and submit and track trouble tickets.
